The tube should be intact, round and have square ends. Use this method to make sure you end up with two equal halves, and that the edges of the cut are parallel. 1. Use a square protractor head set at 90, or a combination square to draw the line of the length of the tube square to one end of the tube at any point around the tube circumference. 2. On a sheet of paper, half the diameter (radius) of the tube is measured from one edge and the parallel line to the edge is drawn. 3. Stand the tube at one end and level the line you drew on the pipe with the line you drew on the paper and then keep the marks aligned to rotate the tube up to the outer diameter of it flush with the edge of the paper. Now, by holding the tube in place to make the mark where the other side of the tube intersects with the line on the paper, this will ensure that the second line is 180 from the first. 4. Use your protractor or square to draw a line the length of the tube square to the end of the tube at mark 180. 5. With sharp scissors cut along both divide the tube into equal halves. 6. Choose one half to use as a reflector and set the other aside for longer use as a back cover. Reflections on... Line LED 1. Cut a piece of aluminum tape long reflector. 2. Before removing the paper release from the tape curl piece to match the reflector, place the piece in the reflector and center it from side to side. There should be exposed cardboard on both sides as the width of the tape is not enough to cover all the concave surface area. Once the tape is located with the same cardboard exposure on both sides make reference marks on the cardboard at the edges of the tape. 3. Remove the paper release from a piece of tape, carefully align it with the reference marks and stick it down, trying to avoid wrinkles, and then smooth it out (see figure 4). 4. Again using the paper used to detect the 180 mark on the pipe, now use it to find and mark the center between the 180 edges at each end of the reflector. 5. Center court sticks at these signs and mark the aluminum ribbon on the edges of the craft stick (see figure 5). 6. Score the tape on these lines with a utility knife to be careful not to cut the cardboard. 7. Remove the central strip of the tape by baring the bare cardboard to then align and glue the LED array (see figure 6). 8. Using a utility knife make a square cut at one end of 2 craft sticks and then cut their reflector length. 9. Glue the face of a single craft stick aligned flush to the edge and ends of each side of the concave side (inside) reflector, then use the clothespins or small spring clamps to keep the sticks in place for a few minutes until the glue dries (see Figure 7). 10. Stand at one end of the reflector on the face of the craft stick and align it with the ends of the reflector edge of the wand (see figure 8), then holding it in place of the scribe line where the edges of the stick intersect the face of the other stick (see Figure 9). Use your utility knife to make these miter cuts on scribe lines (see Figure 10). Then repeat this process for the other end of the reflector. 11. Apply the ball of all glue targets to the mitered ends of one of the pieces you just cut and glue it between the reflector of the edge of the stick flush to the ends and edges. Use strips of scotch as clamps to keep the piece in place for a few minutes until the glue has dried (see figure 11). Repeat this process for the other end of the reflector. 12.
